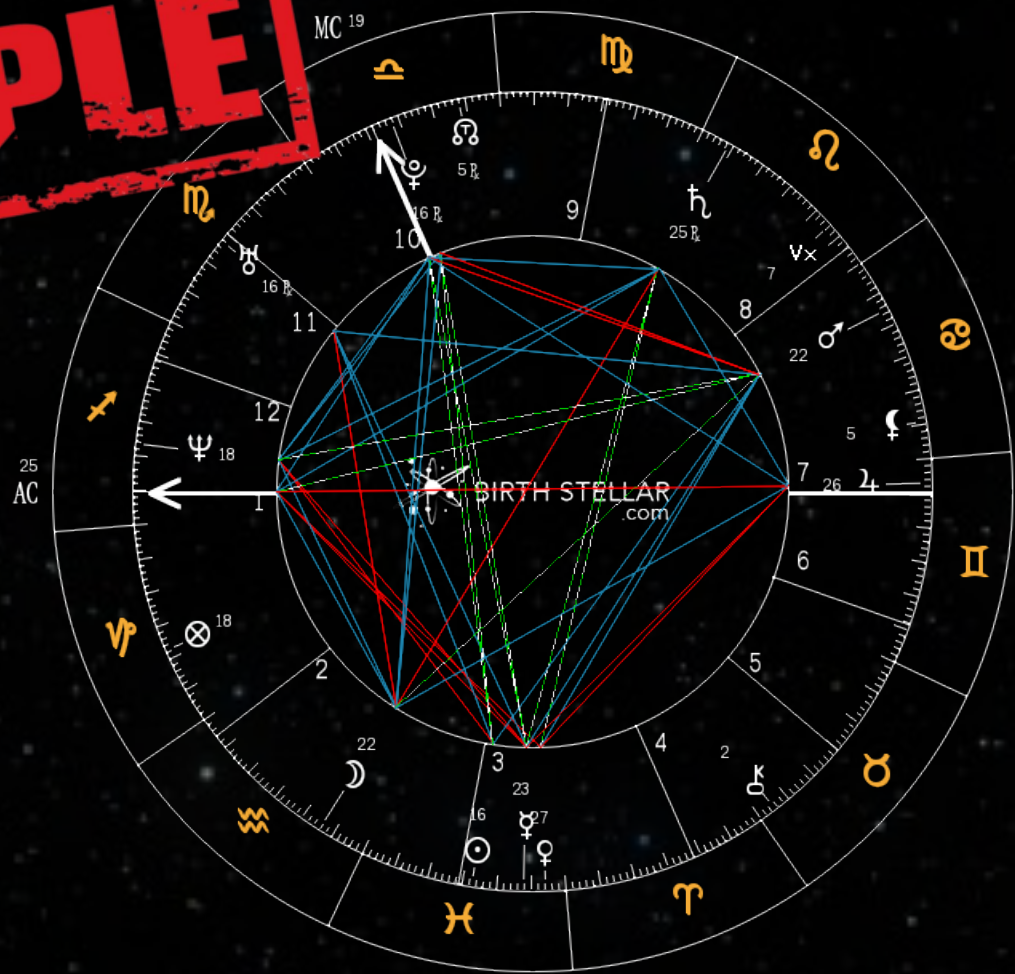

Ascendant in Sagittarius

WHAT IS THE ASCENDANT? In Astrology, the ascendant sign, or simply ascendant, is the sign of the Zodiac that was rising on the horizon at the moment of birth. It represents the characteristics that emerge at first glance, that which bursts forth from a person when they face the world.

Saturn: This planet represents your insecurities and moral values. Considered the Great Malefic, it speaks to how you intend to stand out, your excellence, and your power of determination. The rules that govern our lives and the moral choices we end up making are demonstrated by the analysis of Saturn in the birth chart.

Your Saturn is in the Eighth House, which means you have great challenges and will have to undertake profound changes during your life. Traditionally, the Eighth House was recognized as the house of death. And Saturn in the 8th in a Natal Chart would mean having a horrible death. But modern astrologers have moved away from this line of thought.

I prefer to see the Eighth as the House of Resurrections, those transformations that happen through growth and change. So, you will need to reinvent yourself from time to time.

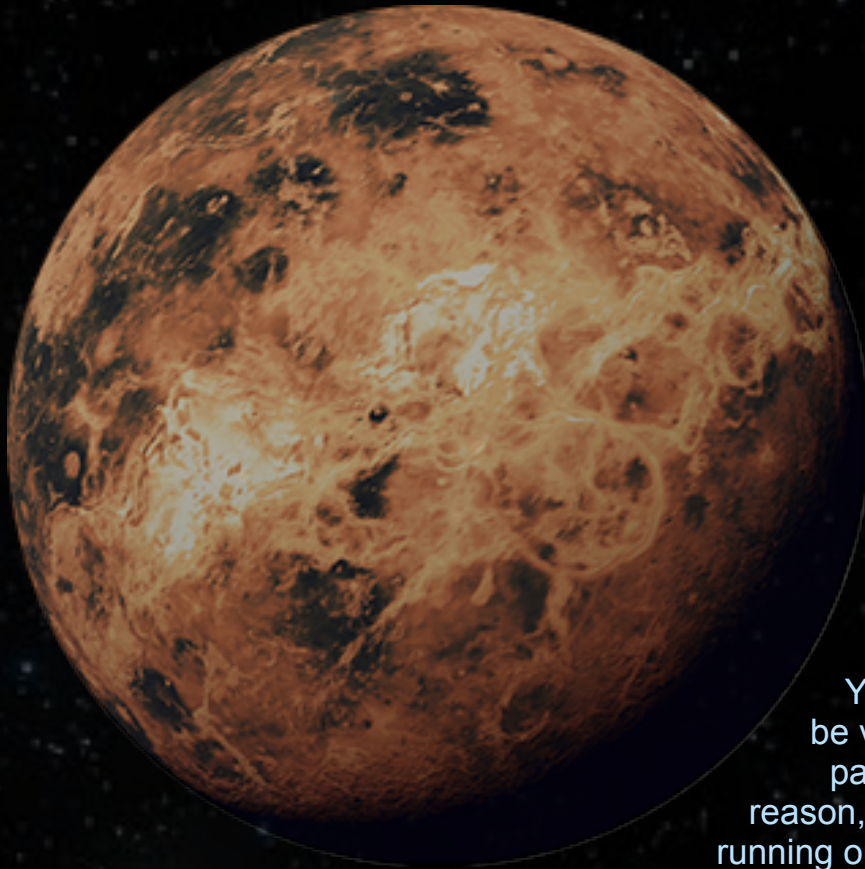
In your Birth Chart, the 8th House is opposite the 2nd House, which symbolizes your attitude towards your possessions. In this sense, life will invite you - or force you - to give up relics of the past so that you can grow and change. In other words: you will have to learn the art of detachment. Which will not be easy at all in your case.

Finances will be a crucial point for you, as you care about those who live beside you. At times, the monetary problems of your loved one may occupy your mind more than your own issues!

Therefore, it is important to be extremely careful with the management of other people's resources or finances. In addition to paying attention to debts and loans. You may find it difficult to receive inheritances or benefits, even if they are yours by legal rights. Lengthy processes involving family members may also occur.

You may find it difficult to change or simply resist transformations, changes and growth. As you hardly accept changes, any alteration in your daily routine can be stressful for you, bringing anxiety. Be aware of this influence and try to minimize these tendencies.

Moon in the Second House

Moon: This celestial body is related to emotional issues and your unconscious mind. It shows how you deal with your sensitivity and the emotional reactions you have to your life. The conditioning you carry from your childhood also comes into consideration here. It represents your relationship with your mother.

Your Moon is in the Second House, and this indicates that when it comes to money, you may have inconsistent attitudes. You may save one day and spend everything the next. You may be very afraid of being in debt and need to feel that the bills will be paid. You need security and financial protection. For the same reason, you tend to put money in a savings account: you are afraid of running out of money in the future! Your financial life may be unstable.

Even so, there are times when you may spend impulsively, on a whim, and this is likely when you are feeling bad. Vanity can be a problem. And you are always looking for admiration and may be quite dependent on others for positive feedback. This will continue until you learn to develop your own feelings of self-worth and self-esteem.

You tend to hold back your emotions and wait a long time before expressing your feelings. When you do, it is with full awareness. You can't swallow your feelings for someone else.
